- Respect all club staff, volunteers and officials and accept their decisions are final
- Be a good sport and act in a sportsmanlike manner at all times
- Treat all bar staff and adult members with respect on club premises
 - Not be rowdy, rude or unruly on club premises
 - Respect all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, culture, religion or sexual identity
 - Not smoke, drink alcohol or take drugs of any kind on club premises
 - Talk to the Club Welfare Officer (Carolyn Tan) about any concerns or worries they have about themselves, coaches, or junior and adult members

Any child who does not respect or adhere to the above will be subject to suspension or a ban from the tennis courts and Beckenham Sports Club.
